

Trailer Smash Rules

Trailer Requirements:

- Trailer ride height can be no higher than 18" to the first horizontal structure of trailer.
- Camper trailers allowed.
- If you have a camper it must be gutted. Bring just a shell.
- Max. trailer length 18'.
- Minimum trailer dimension is 4' wide x 6' long.
- Pickup bed trailers are permitted. Trailer should maintain 18" ride height (bottom of bedside to the ground). Must have bed. No bare pickup frames.
- Boat trailers with boat allowed. Cut off any single vertical metal.
- Dragging a boat is permitted – remove motor.
 - Special hitching rules for boats: Fiberglass boats fall apart very easily so if you follow hitching rules you will not be penalized for not having 6' of your boat left.
 - 1) Use a minimum of 4' of chain.
 - 2) Use 2 – 3'x3'x3/4" plywood to sandwich the hull of the boat.
 - 3) Use 20 – 5/16 bolts and nuts to fasten plywood to boat hull.
 - 4) There must be 1 piece of plywood on outside and one on the inside.
 - 5) Drill two holes through plywood/hull and loop your chain through the holes and bolt the chain back to itself.
 - 6) Your 3'x3' plywood must still be attached to your chain in order to place.
- All trailers must have OEM type wheels & tires and be mounted to an OEM type axle.
- Debris can be placed on flatbed trailers and allowed to fall off. Debris can also be tied to the back of your trailer using cable, chain, or rope only maximum 4' there also. Check with promoter prior to race date to qualify your debris.
- No goosenecks or prior gooseneck trailer.
- Tongue max length 4'.
- Safety chains can be considered as the tongue. Chains and/or tongues will never be considered more than 4'.
- Tongues and chain lengths will not be added together.
- Must have 6' of trailer left attached to pull vehicle in order to win.
- Trailer can be fastened anyway you prefer. *Remember!* you have to have a minimum of 6' of trailer left on your pull vehicle in order to win or qualify in the top 5 positions.
- Trailers consisting of only tongue and axle will not be allowed.
- Trailer must consist of a minimum 4' wide inside to inside of tires, and 6' long body not including tongue.
- Flatbed trailer must put a theme together and have more than an empty flatbed. Keep it "PG" please there are lots of kids in the stands.
- 6' of your trailer must remain in order to be counted. Tongue can only measure 4'. That leaves 2' of the trailers main body to remain present in order to be counted. This two feet has to be beyond "header" cross member that the tongue attaches too.

Debris:

- Large debris such as: couches, chairs, ect. are preferred debris.
- Soft balls, 55 gallon or smaller drums, and things that stay together and bounce around are good debris.
- Absolutely “No” long slender debris such as wood, plastic, and metal.
- A theme/float is preferred. Remember we are attempting to entertain fans. “No fans, No race”.
- No trash will be allowed as debris. No paper of any kind.
- “NO” loose heavy objects can be used for debris. If it is something you wouldn’t want to hit you in the head while racing “don’t use it”.

All debris, vehicles, trailers, etc. can be left on the property. Track will perform all clean up.
